DATE: December 9, 2017

SANCTION: Held Under the sanction of USA Swimming #2017-014K

In granting this sanction, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities, claims, or damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

LOCATION: Colorado Mesa University, El Pomar Natatorium

FACILITIES: 10 lane, 50 Meter Indoor Competition pool which will be set up in a 10 lane, 25 yard configuration with substantial opportunities for warm up and cool down. The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Deck seating is available for swimmers and there is seating for 600 in balcony. No smoking or glass containers in building.

Pool depth: Start end: 8 feet – 2.1336 meters Turn end: 7 feet – 2.1336 meters.

TIMING: Colorado Timing System with touch pads and 8-lane display board will be used for all events. Back-up timing will consist of one button and two stopwatches. Hy-Tek Meet Manager 6.0 software will be used. Meet Mobile will be utilized for instant results.

SCHEDULE: Saturday Session I: Warm-up: 10:00 Start: 10:45

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Zone 4 swimmers holding a 2017 or 2018 USA Swimming Membership card. No deck registrations will be accepted. All participants must be dive certified for safety consideration or the swimmer will be required to start in the water from the edge.

SCORING: Cumulative times will be used to score overall place. Scoring will be broken out by male and female; 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over. Swimmers who DQ an event will have their time adjusted to the slowest legally swam time with a 15 second penalty added.

AWARDS: No awards will be given.

RULES: Age as of December 9, 2017 will determine the swimmer's age group. Exhibition swimming will not be allowed.

All entries must include times or "NT". Submit short course yard times only.

Events will be seeded slowest to fastest.

The meet will be pre-seeded. Please provide scratches by Friday, December 8, at 6:00 PM.

Colorado Swimming, Inc. warm-up procedures will be observed.

The meet referee will have the final authority on all procedures regarding the conduct of the meet. The referee may combine individual events by age, sex, and/or distance.

All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Current certification is mandatory.

Any swimmer entered in the meet unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

The standard CSI warm-up procedures are in effect for this meet. This includes swimmers entering the warm-up lanes using a 3-point feet-first entry where both feet and one hand must be in contact with the deck or end wall immediately prior to entering the water.

The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

On deck photography from behind the starting platforms is prohibited during the starts and relays.

Per USA Swimming rule 302.4, Colorado Swimming Inc. will impose a fine of \$150 per swimmer who shows up on the post meet registration check charged to the team account. Teams will receive one Meet Recon email as a reminder to register the swimmers. As soon as the post meet registration check is run the team will be charged.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Colorado Swimming, Inc. does not support, recommend, endorse or take responsibility for the sale or marketing of any dietary supplements. It is the swimmers' responsibility to know the contents of any food or drink he/she ingests. Deck Changing is prohibited.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

CREDENTIALS: All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Deck Pass is an acceptable proof of membership. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches will be required to sign in and provide proof of credentials with the meet director.

OFFICIALS: We are in need of meet officials. If you are interested in officiating at this meet, please contact Terry Kidd, tldd1@yahoo.com. A mandatory Officials' meeting will be held 30 minutes prior to the session. Officials' attire: standard white over navy blue and white deck shoes.

ENTRIES: Swimmers will choose a series of events to compete. Each swimmer will compete in a total of 5 individual events. Distances cannot be combined. Swimmers will choose either Series A, Series B, or Series C to compete.

Series A: (10 & Under swimmers only!)

25 Back

25 Breast

25 Free

100 IM

Series B: (All swimmers eligible for Series B.)

50 Butterfly

50 Back

50 Breast

50 Free

100 IM

Series C: (All swimmers eligible for Series C.)

100 Butterfly

100 Back

100 Breast

100 Free

200 IM

ENTRY FEES: \$15.00 per swimmer

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

E-mail entries are preferred. "NO TIME" or incorrect times will be placed in the slowest heat. Times for all events should be in short course yards.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

Entries must be delivered via email by 6:00 p.m., Monday, December 4, 2017.

DECK ENTRIES:

The meet will be pre-seeded and because swimmers are competing in a 5 event series, no deck entries should be made and will not be accepted.

PROGRAMS & CONCESSIONS:

There will be no programs at the meet. Heat sheets will be posted on the Maverick webpage, www.maverickaquatics.com, and the Western Slope League site, www.westernslopeleague.org, by Thursday evening.

RESULTS: Results (full team manager backup) will be emailed within 5 days to teams entered in the meet. If time and equipment permit, results may be available at the end of the meet. No paper copies of results will be generated unless requested by a coach.
