Facility: A. Outdoor, 25 yard, 6 lane pool
B. Elevation: 8,768.5'
C. Water Depth: 7' 0" at the start end and 4' 0" at the turn end
D. The competition course is certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

Timing: Colorado Timing System 6 with touch pads and 1 lane display board will be used for all events. Backup timing will consist of two Dolphins and one stopwatch. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used.

Schedule: Warm-up: 9:00am Start: 10:00am

Eligibility: Open only to Western Slope teams and swimmers holding a 2016 USA Swimming membership. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show proof of current membership with either a coach's current team roster printed from the Club Portal or with a mobile device and their Deck Pass account (www.usaswimming.org/deckpass). **NO** deck registrations will be accepted. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

Entry Limit: Swimmers may compete in a maximum of four (4) individual events and two (2) relays.

Entry Fees: One-time \$5.00 fee per swimmer for pool surcharge, \$3.00 per individual entry per swimmer, \$5.00 for each relay event entered. \$0.75 per individual event goes to the CSI Fund and \$0.15 per event goes to Zone 4 Swimming.

Make your check (one only per team) payable to: Town of Telluride.

Entry Process: All entries must be submitted by e-mail using a Hy-Tek file. "No Time" or incorrect times will be placed in the slowest heat. The meet will be pre seeded, except for the 500 free. There will be no re-seeding. **Positive check in will be required for the 500 Free.** The 500 Free will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating girls & boys. Times for all events should be in SCY. A hardcopy of the entry event list should be e-mailed along with the entry file. **NO** deck entries will be accepted. Payment shall be submitted at the meet. Please provide the names of coaches who will be attending the meet for Coaches Packet preparation.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received no later than 12:00pm, June 19, 2017. **NO** late entries will be accepted.

Event Format: Events will be swum slowest to fastest and mixed aged and gender.

Scoring: The meet will be scored as follows:
Individual to six places: 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
Relays will count toward team scores only: 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
Team scores will be kept and announced at the end of the meet
Event scoring will be broken into 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & over, per gender

Awards: Awards for 10 & under: 1st – 3rd place medals. 4th - 6th place ribbons.
Participation awards for 11 & over. Awards for top team.
High Point awards will be given to the top male and female in each age group.

Results: Results will be e-mailed within five (5) days to teams entered in the meet.

Programs/Concessions: Heat sheets will be available for sale at the meet.
Heat sheets will be provided at no cost to coaches and officials.
There will be limited concessions.

Rules:

1. Current USA Swimming rules will govern the procedures of the meet.
2. Age as of June 24th will determine swimmers' age group for competition. Swimmers may swim in only one age group.
3. The Meet Referee(s) will have the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet.
4. Colorado Swimming, Inc. procedures for warm-up will be observed. These procedures are posted throughout the pool area.
5. At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

6. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a race start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
7. Coaches **MUST** declare scratches no later than 30 minutes before the start of the meet. Deck entries **WILL NOT** be accepted.
8. This is a timed final meet with all entries being pre-seeded by the time submitted, except the 500 Free. This event will be seeded after positive check in.
9. 25 yard events will start from the blocks.
10. Only swimmers registered in the meet are allowed to use the pool.
11. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
12. No on deck photography from behind the starting platforms.
13. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Disclaimer: USA Swimming, Inc., Colorado Swimming, Inc., the Town of Telluride, all meet officials, volunteers and sponsors shall be held free from liability or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this meet.

Special Note: No drones, smoking, alcohol, glass, bikes, or dogs allowed within the pool fence. Any rule violation or damage to pool property will be grounds for dismissal from the remainder of the meet and the offenders will be held liable to the fullest extent that the law allows.

Coach/Officials: All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA cards when on the deck. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches that are in non-compliance will not be allowed on deck. A mandatory Officials' meeting will be held at the start of warm-up.
