- Pool:** The Recreation Center pool is an indoor, 6 lane, **25 yard pool** with non-turbulent lane dividers. Continuous warm-up and cool down will be available in the tot pool. The competitions course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).
- Water depth measured at a distance of 3 feet 3 ½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16'5" inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls:
- Turn end all lanes 4' to 5'
 - Start end lanes 1-3, 12' to 6'
 - Start end lanes 4-6, 6' to 4'
- Timing Equipment:** Three (3) timers with manual stop watches per lane. One (1) place judge will be in position for all events.
- Eligibility:** Open to West Slope League swimmers holding a 2017 USA Swimming membership card. Any Swimmer that appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. A surcharge for deck registration will also apply, \$36.00 for year round, \$23.00 for seasonal plus normal registration fee. All efforts will be made to contact the team prior to the meet. Per USA swimming rule 302.4, Colorado Swimming Inc. will impose a fine of \$150 per swimmer who shows up on the post meet registration check charged to the team account. Teams will receive one Meet Recon email as a reminder to register the swimmers. As soon as the post meet registration check is run the team will be charged
- Scoring:** No Individual High Point Awards will be given .
- Awards:** No awards will be given
- Rules:** Current USA rules will govern the procedures of the meet.
a. Age as of June 27 , 2017 will determine the swimmer's age group.
b. Swimmers may enter a **maximum of four (4) individual events per day**

- c. All events will be swum as timed finals with a minimum of 5 minutes between swims.
- d. Entries will be pre-seeded slowest to fastest by the time submitted.
- e. Clerk of Course must be notified of scratches.
- f. There will be NO heating area for 8 & Under events. All swimmers must report to the assigned lane and heat at the proper time.
- g. Each team will be responsible for providing lane timers.
- h. No smoking allowed in the facility.
- i. No glass allowed in the deck area.
- j. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- k. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.
- l. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. On deck changing is not allowed.
- m. No on deck photography from behind the starting platforms.
- n. All coaches and officials must display a current USA swimming Credential Card that includes a current background check date and a current Athlete Protection or Safe Sport Program training date
- o. Referee will be the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet

Warm-Up: General Warm-Up Session first 40 minutes
Specific Warm-Up Session 20 minutes following general

Procedures:

General:

- NO DIVING – Swimmers must enter the water feet first
- No sprinting or pace work
- All lanes will be used for general warm-up
- Circle swimming only

Specific:

- Push/Pace in specified lanes at designated times.
- Push off one or two lengths from starting end, circle swimming only. NO DIVING, feet first entries only.
- Racing Starts in specified lanes at designated times.
- Sprint lanes for race starts from blocks or for backstroke starts.

**Facility
Information:**

The aquatic complex deck will be closed to the general public (including swim parents). No public swim will be available during the meet. The mezzanine overlooking the pool will be open for all to observe the meet.

NO TENTS ON THE LAWN PLEASE.
NO PETS ON RECREATION CENTER PROPERTY. PARK
IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS.

Any damage to any area of the Recreation Center and pool area will be grounds for dismissal from the meet. Teams with swimmers responsible for the damage will be billed for all damages.
