Pool:

The Recreation Center pool is an indoor, 6 lane, 25 yard pool with non-turbulent lane dividers. Continuous warm-up and cool down will be available in the tot pool. The competitions course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). **water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3 ½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls**

4 feet at 1 meter to 5 feet at 5 meters at turn end

12 – 6 feet lanes 1- 3

6 - 4.6 feet lanes 4 - 6 at start end at 1 meter

5 feet at 5 meters from start end

Timing Equipment:

Three (3) timers per lane. One (1) place judges will be in position for all events.

Hy-Tek Meet Managersoftware will be used

Eligibility:

Open to all West Slope member swimmers holding a 2017 USA Swimming membership card. Any Swimmer that appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. A surcharge for deck registration will also apply, \$36.00 for year round, \$22.00 for seasonal plus normal registration fee. All efforts will be made to contact the team prior to the meet. All deck entries must present proof of current registration.

Per USA swimming rule 302.4, Colorado Swimming Inc. will impose a fine of \$150 per swimmer who shows up on the post meet registration check charged to the team account. Teams will receive one Meet Recon email as a reminder to register the swimmers. As soon as the post meet registration check is run the team will be charged

Rules:

Current USA rules will govern the procedures of the meet.

- a. Age as of July 18, 2017 will determine the swimmer's age group.
- b. Swimmers may compete in their own age group or in Open events.
- c. All events will be swum as timed finals with a minimum of 5 minutes between swims.
- d. Entries will be pre-seeded by the time submitted.
- e. Each team will be responsible for providing lane timers.
- f. No smoking allowed in the facility or on the patio.
- g. No glass allowed in the deck area or on the patio.
- h. Referee will be the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet.
- i. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. .
- j. All swimmers without a coach must report to the Meet Director or Meet Referee to make arrangements to be supervised by a CSI registered coach.
- k. All coaches and officials must display a current USA swimming Credential Card that includes a current background check date and a current Athlete Protection or Safe Sport Program training date

Warm-Up

Procedures:

GENERAL WARM-UP SESSION

- NO DIVING – Swimmers must enter the water feet first
- No sprinting or pace work
- All lanes will be used for general warm-up
- Race Starts/Sprints, will be during general warm up session in the assigned team lanes

Facility Information:

The aquatic complex deck will be closed to the general public (including swim parents). No public swim will be available during the meet.

ONLY OFFICIALS, TIMERS, HELPERS, COACHES, AND SWIMMERS WILL BE ALLOWED ON DECK!

The mezzanine overlooking the pool will be open for all to observe the meet.

NO TENTS ON THE LAWN PLEASE.

NO PETS ON RECREATION CENTER PROPERTY.

PARK IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS.

Any damage to any area of the Recreation Center and pool area will be grounds for dismissal from the meet. Teams with swimmers responsible for the damage will be billed for all damages.

No smoking in any area of the recreation center facility

No alcohol beverages are allowed in any area of the recreation center facility.

All participants by entry will release the City of Delta, its officers, agents, and employees from liability for any and all injuries or damages which may result. Colorado Swimming, Inc does not support, recommend, endorse or take responsibility for the sale or marketing of any dietary supplements. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. . No on deck photography from behind the starting platforms. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus , is prohibited over the venue(pools, athlete/ coaches area and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes , coaches, officials and /or spectators are present.
